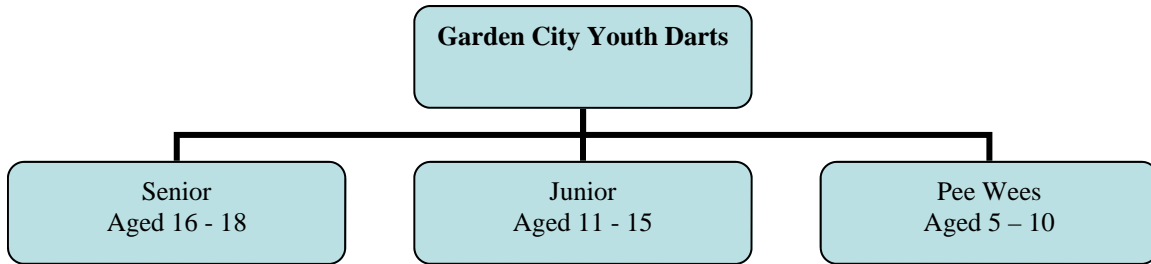


GARDEN CITY YOUTH DARTS



The Dart League for all divisions will be hosted every Sunday Morning (10-11:30 AM) at the Britannia Legion, 780 Summit Ave. Age categories are based on the player's age as of October 1. National qualification for age categories: Senior 18 or under as of October 1; Junior 15 or under as of October 1.

\$15 of the annual registration fees will be used to cover the costs of membership to Dart BC which is required to attend the provincial youth dart shoot. The additional fees will be applied to off-set the costs of the year end banquet, trophies and other such needs. Fundraising will be required throughout the year. The Britannia Legion is generously donating the space for the Amateur Youth Darts.

Youth not registered in the league will be allowed to "drop in" for a maximum of three days before having to register to continue playing in the league. Drop in players will be required to pay a \$2.00 fee per day. No dart player will be denied membership due to lack of ability to pay the fee. Please speak with one of the coaches for more information.

Additional fundraising will be required for those players attending the Youth Provincials (which will be hosted in Victoria during the week of spring break in 2010); and for those who qualify at the Provincial play-downs for the Canadian Nationals which will be held in Newfoundland in May of 2010.

Goals for this program include:

- Teaching the fundamentals and sportsmanship associated with the game of darts.
- Creating a fun, safe environment for youth to socialize and recreate.
- Introducing both the recreational and competitive aspects of the sport to youths.
- Promote a positive self esteem for each participant.
- Promoting the development of academic skills such as math, concentration, turn taking, hand/eye coordination, and social skill development.
- Youth ambassadors for Victoria and B.C. in competitive play.

Age as of October 1. Youth Players must not be over the age of 19 as of October 1 in order to qualify to play in the BC Provincial and or Canadian Nationals. Those individuals who reach 19 years of age during the year may continue to play but must adhere to the Darts BC and NDFC rules of play as they apply to the youth program.

Players are ambassadors for our community; those attending local, provincial and/or Canadian National Shoots must adhere to the National Dart Federation of Canada (NDFC) rules of play. Breach of these rules could result in removal from the Victoria and/or the B.C. teams.
